Is the student a danger to self, or others, or does the student need immediate assistance for any reason? "I AM NOT SURE" Students in Distress: The student shows signs of distress (e.g., signs of "YES" "NO" depression or anxiety, recent trauma, deteriorating academic The student's conduct is clearly and imminently reckless, I am not concerned for the student's immediate safety, but the performance, etc.), but I am not sure how serious it is. My interaction has disorderly, dangerous, or threatening and is suggestive of harm student is having significant academic and/or personal issues left me feeling uneasy and/or concerned about the student to self or others in the community and could use some support or additional resources. Distressing Student: The student exhibits disruptive behavior (e.g., violating boundaries, intimidating or threatening behavior, expressing thought of harm.)
